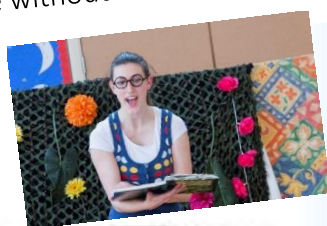

Twelfth Night

A shipwreck, cross dressing, mistaken identity, sword fights, high jinks and yellow stockings brought to life in a fun packed interactive show. Pupils become part of the action, helping with sound effects playing small parts, acting with the professional actors. Pupils will be able to explore the motivations of the characters and the themes throughout the show. In keeping with 2018's theme of Storytelling and Poetry, our use of a storyteller and simplified storyline ensures pupils can follow the play throughout.
